

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university in any major/minor combination which includes the pre-requisite courses listed on the web site. Majors include (but are not limited to) Medical Technology, Pre-Medical Biology/Chemistry, Forensics, and Nursing.
- We prefer at least an overall 3.0 GPA from the undergraduate degree.
- We do not require the GRE test.
- A shadowing or work experience which reflects what a PA does in every day

practice. Please contact us if you cannot arrange this yourself.

- 2 references from a professor, PA or work supervisor.
- The application period is from January 1 – May 31 of every year for the class beginning the following January.
