Be familiar with narrative comments and performance. You'll have an opportunity to review MSPE prior to Oct 1 release. You may alert your campus dean of factual errors in the MSPE (e.g., incorrect designation of honors grade); however, we may not make substantial changes (e.g., purge or modify a clerkship narrative).
