

Designation of Academic and Professional Standing

Currently or formerly enrolled MD degree students may inquire about their designated academic, professional and/or disciplinary status in the MD degree program or in MD degree combined programs. The designation and communication of good standing is contingent upon probationary status. Probation is imposed by the Committee on Academic and Professional Standards, or the Dean, or the Dean's designee. Any form of probation (e.g., academic, professional and/or disciplinary) defines the student as NOT in good standing.

Formerly enrolled students who were not in a probationary status at the time of graduation or withdrawal may be designated with good standing.

Currently enrolled students who are not in a probationary status at the time of inquiry may be designated with good standing.

Students needing written confirmation of their standing should contact the appropriate campus Student Services office.
